

Highways/Footpaths/Traffic Issues

The Parish Council has now conducted a survey of all streets within the Parish and submitted a report to NELC for consideration for the Traffic Regulation Order concerning parking on verges and footways. Further action is now awaited from NELC and finally it is hoped that this can be in place by the end of this current year.



Local Community News

Humberston & New Waltham Ward Update October 2019

Crime

There have been 38 reported crimes across the Humberston & New Waltham Ward for September. There were 21 reports for Humberston.

Seven of these were at Tesco's including six shop thefts and a criminal damage.

Burglary: 2

Over the 13th & 14th September a property under renovation on Church Avenue was entered. Copper piping was stolen.

About 9pm on 21st September a burglary was reported at a property on St Christopher's Road. Two suspects are alleged to have forced their way into the kitchen and arm themselves with items from the house, threatening the occupier demanding money. A mobile phone was stolen.

Commercial Burglary: 4

About 2pm on 14th September a burglary occurred at the Beachcomber Holiday Centre when a person has entered the DJ booth, cut a security wire and stole a lap top.

During the early hours of 16th September a number of males have entered the premises of Clee Metals on Wilton Road after making a hole in an outer wall. A large amount of various metals have been stolen. The premises was again attacked overnight 23rd & 24th September resulting in a large amount of various metals were stolen.

Also over the same night, the shutter was forced open at the McColl's store giving access to the store. The tobacco cabinet was attacked and property stolen.

Vehicle Crime: 1

Overnight 5th & 6th September an insecure car parked outside its address on the Fitties was entered. Loose change was stolen.

Criminal Damage: 6

Window smashed on the Persimmon Building site on Humberston Avenue.

Car bodywork damaged whilst parked on the Country Club carpark.
Coach House Pub male caused damage to the bodywork of a taxi.





Ward Councillor Notes

After a period of pause, once again Humberston is attracting more planning applications. A small development at Forest Way has gained planning permission, a similar sized application behind South View has stalled and a large development on land near Midfield Road has arrived with a planning application imminent. Ward councillors are working with all parties to attempt to resolve planning issues that concern residents.

Recycling

NELC have recently issued a reminder of what can be recycled in the recycling boxes after recent finds of contamination including plant pots, tins of paint and even a bath tub.

Orange recycling boxes are for drink cans, food tins, household aerosols and plastic bottles. The only plastics that go in the orange box are plastic bottles.

Blue recycling boxes are for paper and small card.

Green recycling box is for glass bottles and glass jars.

HUMBERSTON WENDOVER PADDOCK

Did you know ????

THE PADDOCK WAS PROVIDED BY THE INHABITANTS OF HUMBERSTON AS A MEMORIAL TO THOSE WHO SERVED IN THE SECOND WORLD WAR 1939-1945.

During World War 2, 130 men and women left the village of Humberston to join the armed services , and of them, 4 became Prisoners of War and 9 persons died. The names of the fallen are on the War memorial which is situated in the graveyard of St Peter's Church.

The Paddock itself consists of a playing field for the children of the village, purchased by the villagers through the Humberston Memorial Scheme set up in 1944 to provide a tangible form of memorial for the benefit of the parishioners. The memorial was paid for by the villagers themselves and was purchased for an unknown sum. The field originally was owned by Lord Carrington.

As part of the Parish Councils VE day event we would love to hear any stories or have sight of any photos of any of the 130 men and women mentioned above.





UNBELIEVABLY EASY MINCE PIES

These are so easy and there's no rolling of the pastry!!

Ingredients:

225g cold butter, diced -

350g plain flour

100g golden caster sugar

280g mincemeat

1 small egg and icing sugar to dust

To make the pastry, rub the butter into the flour until it looks like fine breadcrumbs and then stir in the sugar.

Make the pastry into a ball—don't add any liquid—so you get a fairly firm dough like ball. Chill it or use it straightaway.

Preheat oven to gas mark 6/200 degrees or 180 degrees for fan oven

Use walnut sized balls of dough and press 12 balls into greased patty tins

Spoon the mincemeat into the patty tins

Use rest of dough to make the lids by getting 12 small balls and flattening them in your hands to make flat discs for the lids

Put the lids on top—you don't need to use any liquid to make them stick, they will do that on their own.

You can now freeze them at this stage or refrigerate to cook later.

Before you cook, beat the egg and brush over the top of the pies

Bake for 20 minutes and whilst still warm, sprinkle icing sugar over.

They will keep up to about 3 days in a tin.
