19/113 Planning Matters

The following planning applications were considered:

Planning Application Reference: DM/1006/19/REM

Proposal: Reserved matters application pursuant to planning application DM/0298/17/OUT (Outline application to demolish existing dwelling and erect 5 dwellings with all matters reserved) for the appearance of plots 1 to 4 - addition Of rooms to roofspace

Location: Land At 18 Humberston Avenue Humberston North East Lincolnshire

Cllr. Scoffin left the room for this application taking no part in discussion or debate. Chairman advised there was one objection on the website and NELC had advised they would be contacting the resident to go through their queries. No objections.

Planning Application Reference: DM/0982/19/FUL

Proposal: Demolish existing shed, lobby and bay window, partial conversion of roof space to include installation of dormer to front, erect single storey front extension and two storey rear extension to include the installation of roof lights to the side with various internal and external alterations

Location: 7 Richardson Close Humberston Grimsby North East Lincolnshire

Agreed that this was a very large development on a close with all single storey existing dwellings and all small scale dwellings in small plots. Concerns over overall size and mass and the resulting size of such a

RESOLVED: That Cllr. Scoffin, Clerk and Chairman agree order of suitable marquee at maximum Cost of £2,000 for purchase of marquee excluding VAT and the marquee be stored in the Cemetery shed
